- Dogs must be current on all required vaccinations, including Bordetella and Leptospirosis, seven days prior to their first class or lesson.
- If vaccinated at another facility, a copy of the current vaccination record from a licensed veterinarian is required in advance of the first session.
- Fees must be paid prior to the first class.
- No refunds after the first day of class.
- We reserve the right to turn away any dog that may be ill or contagious, or dog and/or people aggressive.
